Academic Session 2020-2021

The Academic Session 2020-21 was started at St. Mary's Academy in the first week of April through virtual mode with the commitment that the Academy would not let the students suffer in their studies owing to the complete Lockdown situation because of the Pandemic.

On 7th of May, the Online Essay Activity was organized for the parents of the students of classes 6th to 12th with the motive to divert their attention from the stress building Pandemic to other positivity building areas of life.
